



Call for Candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize (PhD)

EuPA-YIP. The European Proteomics Association (www.EuPA.org) hereby announces a call for candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize to be awarded at the 4th EuPA Scientific Meeting from October 23-27, 2010 in Estoril (Portugal). A special session will be dedicated to presentations which will be given by the finalists selected from the submitted abstracts. The winner, judged by the panel after the presentations, will receive €1.000, sponsored by the Journal of Proteomics, and a EuPA certificate. The winner of the Young Investigator Prize will also be announced in the major proteomics journals.

Eligibility. To qualify, candidates must have started or obtained their PhD or MD degree, and within three years of completion of their degree at the time of submission, member of a EuPA affiliated society and working in a European laboratory. Candidates can either be nominated by senior researchers (PhD, MD or equivalent) or by a EuPA affiliated national proteomics society.

Submission. EuPA-YIP candidates should register, submit an abstract and attend the 4th EuPA Meeting. In addition, abstracts should be sent with two letters of support to Dr Garry Corthals (firstname.lastname@btk.fi) no later than 31 August 2010. EuPA-YIP finalists will be selected to hold a presentation and will be notified prior to the conference. Registration & Abstract Submission to the meeting are open at <http://eupa2010.fc.ul.pt>.
